International mission work was started in the Church of God in 1912. Since that time, many mission projects have been promoted in many countries. These projects have been directed by various organizations within the General Conference including the National Missionary Society, the Department of Evangelism and Missions, and later by a Foreign Mission Board.

We are currently working directly in many countries on four continents – Haiti, Malawi, Mozambique, Pakistan, Tanzania, Mexico, Peru, and Kenya.

Our Purpose

1. To become a trained professional sending agency by understand mission science, by understanding culture and by understanding world politics.
2. To establish a training program for missionaries.
3. To send trained missionaries to develop and establish mission fields.

Our Ministries

Africa: Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique, Tanzania

There are approximately 200 congregations in Africa that are affiliated with the Church of God General Conference. The churches vary in size from 15-20 to 125 members. The work is very viable. There are many dedicated pastors and workers who are godly people, furthering the Word of the Kingdom of God. They are very enthusiastic and excited about sharing the gospel.

Haiti

In 1994, through study of Scripture, Pastor Lesly Bertrand and a group of ministers came to understand the Biblical truths that we hold dear. In 1996, after being asked to leave their denomination, they formed their own fellowship of about 20 churches. Pastor Lesly runs an orphanage for boys in Croix des Bouquets. Hurricanes and a massive earthquake have devastated Haiti during the time we have worked there. We have provided financial support to assist in feeding people and providing for their needs. Teams have gone in 2011 and 2012 to help construct school buildings that had been destroyed. We are currently working to build more churches as the ministry grows.

Peru

We currently work with a congregation in Lima that has been accepted into membership in the Church of God General Conference. The church is reaching out with Bible studies in villages outside of Lima. There are other pastors and churches that are also in touch with us about joining our growing presence there. In the spring of 2005, the Church Builders raised funds for a permanent meeting place for the congregation in Lima.

Mexico

Our work in Mexico officially began on September 9, 1963. Bro. Roberto Badillo led our work in Labor Vieja until his death in 2006. Mission trips were made to Mexico from 1987 until 1992 and from 2000 to 2009. Currently, the political situation has made it impossible to return safely. Since Pastor Roberto's death, his widow, Lupe, has continued his work, teaching the children in Sunday school each week.

Pakistan

In early 2009 we were contacted by some pastors in Pakistan about being affiliated with the Church of God General Conference. They had become aware of our organization through various websites. There are currently eight congregations that have been accepted into membership in the Church of God General Conference. There are other pastors and churches that are also in touch with us who may wish to join our Conference.
